Note: World cup classes will take priority. Other classes will be flown in available time without disrupting the world cup classes.

A sport range will also be run by other UK clubs during the weekend.

CONTEST RULES:

The competition will be held according to the latest FAI Sporting Code.
The event is open to individuals with a valid FAI Sporting Licence.

LOCAL RULES:

The airfield is provided to us by the UK ministry of defence. It is essential that we leave no litter to ensure continued use of the airfield. There is therefore a local rule as follows:

A flight will be disqualified if any part of the model, as launched, becomes detached. The exceptions to this rule are for S4 (boost glider), where the engine may be ejected in accordance with 8.2.4.1 and 8.2.4.2, S7 (scale) and S1 (altitude) where a model is staged. In all cases, the in-flight discarding of ejection pistons and/or wadding will result in the flight being disqualified.

ABOUT GRANTHAM AND THE FLYING SITE

The town of Grantham is adjacent to the A1 road, the great north road between London and Edinburgh. It is notable as the birth place of Margaret Thatcher and the place where the world record steam engine speed was achieved. The bad news is that it has also been voted the most boring place in England.

The flying site is around 10 miles from the town centre. It is an active military airfield during the week covering a huge area. There is one main runway and a perimeter track in concrete, with the rest of the airfield is covered in cut grass. At the weekend the airfield is used for leisure purposes and the BMFA have access to the site for their free flight and power nationals there each year.

We are arranging a special deal to base the event at a hotel in Grantham and details will follow shortly.

Getting to Grantham by Air

The nearest airport to Grantham is East Midlands airport, (<http://www.eastmidlandsairport.com/emaweb.nsf>). This is about 40 miles away and is served by many of the main low cost airlines. The other convenient airfields are Stansted (<http://www.stanstedairport.com/>) and London Luton (<http://www.london-luton.co.uk/en/>) both of which are serviced by many low cost airlines.

Getting to Grantham by Train

Grantham is serviced by fast trains form London Kings Cross on the main line to the North East of England and on to Edinburgh.

Getting to Grantham by Car

Grantham is located adjacent to main A1 road, the Great North Road and is easily accessible from all parts of England.

By road: From the North: A1 turn off at the A607 junction towards Grantham. At the mini-round about take the first exit and then immediately right into the hotel's free car park.
